

Audience Award Ballot Contest - Official Contest Rules and Regulations

The Sponsors of the contest are:

1. The Prize

There is **one** prize available to be won consisting of a **12 day Mediterranean Tapestry Cruise aboard the Nieuw Amsterdam for two (2) people** sailing on **April 18, 2011**. *Note: To arrive on time for the sailing passengers must depart their gateway city in time to be at the ship April 18, 2011, 14h00 (CEST)*. The selected entrant will be part of a small **LGBT** group on this cruise. The cruise includes standard outside stateroom accommodations, port charges and round trip economy airfare for two (2) people, departing from the major Canadian gateway city closest to the selected entrant's residence.

2. How To Enter, No Purchase Necessary

The contest runs from 8pm EST May 20, 2010 to 10pm EST May 30, 2010. At every public screening during the Inside Out Film Festival from May 20th to 30th, 2010 audience members who are residents of Canada and who are of the age of majority in their province or territory of residence, will have an opportunity to complete a ballot rating the film(s) after the screening. To enter the contest the email and phone number of the entrant must be entered on the ballot and dropped in a Festival Ballot Box. All completed ballots will be entered in a random draw to take place at the Closing Night Gala Party at the Gardiner Museum, 111 Queen's Park (South of Bloor Street) on May 30, 2010 at 11pm EST. The Closing Night Gala Party starts at 10pm.

3. Selection of Winner and Eligibility

A random draw will be held on Sunday May 30, 2010 at 11pm EST from all eligible entries received and the selected entrant will be notified by telephone and email within 72 hours of the draw. The contest closes at 10pm on May 30th, 2010. No ballots will be accepted after that time. The chances of winning are dependent upon the total number of eligible entries received.

Before being declared the winner, the selected entrant and the primary passenger and travel companion will be required to sign a Release Form, confirming compliance with the contest rules and acceptance of the prize as offered, and releasing the Contest Sponsor, participating sponsors, Expedia CruiseShipCenters Rosedale, The Inside Out Lesbian and Gay Film Festival Inc, Royal Bank of Canada and their respective officers, directors, employees and agents from any responsibility for any injury, accident, loss, damages, misfortune or expense resulting from the use or enjoyment of the prize.
