Volunteer Policies and Procedures

BY REGISTERING TO VOLUNTEER WITH INSIDE OUT, YOU AGREE THAT YOU HAVE READ THESE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AND WILL ADHERE TO THEM FOR THE TERM OF YOUR VOLUNTEER COMMITMENT. (Thanks. It's actually pretty easy.)

SIGN-UP PROCESS

1. Volunteer sign-ups for 2017 are now closed.
2. Shift sign-ups take place on-line. You will be sent a link once you have attended an orientation.
3. You must sign up for a minimum of two shifts.
4. Indicate your availability according to your schedule. It's advisable *not* to indicate availability for times that include films you want to see. Volunteers on shifts do not sit in on films that are screening.
5. Please only sign up for shifts you can commit to.
6. Keep in mind that you will get a ticket-voucher at the end of each volunteer shift.
7. If you have any questions about specific volunteer roles before signing up, read the description of Volunteer Roles (on Volunteer Webpage) or contact Steen Starr (volunteer@insideout.ca).
8. If you need to cancel a shift you must do so **48 hours** prior to the start of the shift. If something comes up less than 48 hours before your shift, you **MUST** contact Steen Starr at volunteer@insideout.ca.

SCREENING VOUCHERS

- After you have finished your shift you will receive a voucher that can be exchanged at the Box Office for a ticket to a regular screening. The Box Office is located at the TIFF Bell LightBox Box Office. 1 voucher = 1 regular screening; 2 vouchers = 1 Gala screening (dependent on availability)
- If you are volunteering over closing weekend you will receive either: a regular voucher; an Inside Out voucher in advance of your shift, a voucher for one of Inside Out's More-Play screenings, or a voucher for any regular programming at TIFF.
- One voucher is earned for every shift of 6 hours or less. Two vouchers are earned for every shift over six hours.

CONDUCT POLICIES

- **Punctuality – Do not** be late – all volunteers should be at the venue and **ready to start** for the beginning of your shift. (If you need to change into your t-shirt, have a snack or go to the washroom beforehand, please arrive in time to do so).
- **Alcohol – Do not** consume alcohol or other illicit substances during your shift – volunteers should behave in a professional manner at all times while on duty.
- **Media – Do not** make official comments to the media – direct all media inquiries to the FOH staff, who will direct them to the appropriate Inside Out staff members.
- **Social Media – Refrain** from making critical or negative comments about film programming on any social media channels while you are a volunteer. As a volunteer you represent the Festival and are host to our industry guests, filmmakers, other artists and audience members.

- **Cellphones** – Limit your cellphone use to times when your shift is quiet. If you are seen to be using your cellphone when there are tasks to be done you will be asked to put it away.
- **Gifts – Do not** accept gifts from Festival patrons – Inside Out has a ‘no gift’ policy. Please be respectful of this and our patrons.
- **Respect – Do not** engage in inappropriate behavior with guests during your shift
- **Parties** – All party volunteers must be at least 19 years of age.
- **FUN** – Please **DO** have fun and treat everyone with respect. Our outstanding volunteers are the face of Inside Out during the Festival. Continue making us proud!
- **Help** – If you need assistance for any reason reach out to the front-of-house staff first, or contact **Steen Starr** (volunteer@insideout.ca) or **Jayne Schneider** (festival@insideout.ca) 416.977.6847, xt 30.

NOTE: Failure to adhere to any of the above policies will result in a volunteer being sent home and any future shifts being canceled.



VOLUNTEER T-SHIRTS

- Pick up your t-shirt before your first shift. Tees can be picked up at the Guest Relations Desk at the TIFF Bell LightBox any day beginning May 25, 2017. This desk will be open at 4:15 (for volunteers) on weekdays and 11:30 on weekends. The earlier in the Festival you come, the better chance you have of getting the right size. Everyone gets one t-shirt and must sign for it when it is received.
- If you are working the Opening VIP Reception, your t-shirt will be provided for you there.
- Wear your t-shirt to every shift or you will be given a back-up that may not be the right size.
- Do not cut or alter your shirt until after the Festival, and look clean and tidy while volunteering.
- Only wear your volunteer t-shirt while on shift until after the Festival.

Please be aware...

- Different volunteer roles have different requirements. If you have any questions about your role, please check in with the Volunteer Captain on duty or contact Steen Starr at **volunteer@insideout.ca**.
- Most shifts are 4-7 hours and include short breaks, but you won't have time for a full lunch or dinner break so make sure you eat before coming.
- Front of House shifts usually involve some work outside, so bring (or wear) appropriate clothing. Layers are a good idea!
- Please have fun and treat everyone with respect. Our outstanding volunteers are the face of Inside Out during the Festival. Continue making us proud!
